

Bohol, Tagbilaran City to host CVIRAA 2011

The Provincial Government of Bohol, and the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Tagbilaran City will jointly host this year's Central Visayas Regional Athletic Association (CVIRAA) Meet which will be held on November 28 - December 2, 2011 at Carlos P. Garcia (CPG) Sports Complex, Tagbilaran City, Bohol.

The unrelentless efforts of Hon. Edgar M. Chatto, Bohol Provincial Governor, and Hon. Dan Neri Lim, City Mayor of Tagbilaran City, have kept the preparations on track, particularly the playing venues, billeting quarters, athletic facilities, and other necessities to guarantee the success of this year's CVIRAA.

On November 28, 2011, 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M., the Regional Development Council (RDC) composed of the Provincial Governors of the Provinces of Bohol, Cebu, Negros Oriental, and Siquijor, and the City/Municipality Mayors of the cities and municipalities of Region VII, will convene for the Regional Development Council Meeting prior to the Opening Program, which is scheduled at 4:00 P.M. at the CPG Sports Complex.

The Parade of Athletes, Coaches, Officiating Officials, Meet Officials, and Guests will unfold the athletics events on November 28, 2011 at 3:00 P.M.

Individual and team sports competition will be played starting November 29, 2011, in different playing venues. Playoffs will be on December 2, 2011. Cultural tilts in Balitaw, Vocal Solo, Kundiman, and Folk Dance will showcase the students' agility and grace. Students/Pupils who are academically witty will contend for the academic competitions in English, Science, and Math.

Winners of different contest categories will be awarded with trophies and medals during the Awarding Ceremonies on December 2, 2011 at 6:00 P.M.

Meanwhile, DepED VII Regional Director Recaredo G. Borgonia bid for excellent performance among Regional Working Committee members. "Do your job well and do it right. Everything that we do must educate the people", he stressed. He enjoined all members of the Regional Working Committees to get the communication lines open to avoid problems to occur.

Assistant Regional Director Carmelita T. Dulangon also reminded everyone to start the activity on time and train the athletes to value punctuality. She pointed out that Sec. Armin A.
